The University of the Philippines National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development (UP NISMED) in cooperation with UNESCO International Bureau of Education (IBE – Geneva), International Council of Associations for Science Education (ICASE) – Asian Chapter, Department of Education, Commission on Higher Education, and Department of Science and Technology – Science Education Institute will hold an international conference on science and mathematics education on October 27 – 29, 2008 at UP NISMED, Diliman, Quezon City.
